Requirements with these stipulations: lab science select BIOL 1153/1151 and select another without the BIOL prefix; fine arts HUNA 2563 is required; history/government POLS 2753 is required and select either HIST 2753 or 2763.
2. These courses are used to determine major GPA. See Graduation Requirements section of this catalog.
3. Requirements for Admission in Educator Preparation Program (EPP). Must be completed with required grades for admission requirements. Consult with faculty advisor regarding School of Education admission requirements and for courses taken after admission to program.
4. Must be admitted to the School of Education, Educator Preparation Program.
5. The department requires students to meet a piano proficiency. Students with little or no piano abilities will be required to pass (with a minimum grade of C) up to four hours of class piano (MUSC 1161, 1171, 2161, and 2171).

Prior to graduation students must demonstrate competency in financial literacy by satisfactory completion of FIN 1521 Personal Finance Applications (or an approved substitution) with a grade of C or better, or by a score of 70% or more on a challenge exam for FIN 1521.

A student earning a Bachelor of Music Education vocal music degree will have completed the requirements to be eligible to apply for teacher licensure in instrumental music 12 as issued by the Arkansas State Department of Education.

Students must earn a C or higher in all courses on the degree plan. Students must maintain a 2.75 cumulative GPA or better. GPA is tracked throughout the program and verified for admission into internship.

**Student Degree Program Requirements**

A student's degree program requirements are those specified in the catalog in effect at the time of declaration of program. If not on the Guaranteed 8-semester degree plan, students may choose to meet the program requirements specified in the catalog year from when they began their program of study. Students must meet the above program requirements and the graduation requirements at the institutional and college policy. The program can be changed only with the approval of the advisor. If original courses are eliminated, students may be required to meet new curriculum requirements in the degree program. If students are not enrolled for two consecutive terms (excluding summer terms), they must re-enter under the program requirements of the current catalog. Students are responsible for understanding program requirements and changes. Guaranteed 8-semester Degree Completion Program Pursuant to Act 1014 of 2005, qualified first-time freshmen with a declared major may also participate in the guaranteed 8-semester degree completion program. Students must follow the above degree plan and meet all requirements as outlined in the Guaranteed 8-semester Degree Completion Program contract. The contract and this degree plan must be signed and filed with the advisor before the first day of classes for the student's first term of attendance.
